

Guidelines and Rules for Use of an Off-Leash Area

(Humans should read this sign; dogs should obey their humans)

For a safe and enjoyable dog walking experience, please adhere to these guidelines and rules.

- This is a shared, multi-use facility; respect other dogs and their humans.
- Dogs are to be wearing a current license, identification and owner contact tag(s).
- Dogs must be accompanied by their human who must be able to maintain effective verbal control of their dog at all times.
- Dogs involved in aggressive incidents must leave the area immediately (Dogs must be both dog and human friendly. Humans must at least be dog friendly).
- Dogs must be: a minimum of six months of age, immunized and spayed/neutered.
- A leash not exceeding two meters (six feet) must be carried at all times.
- Wildlife does not like dogs...Dogs, please do not chase wildlife.
- Designated bags and containers are provided for pick-up and disposal of your dogs waste – dogs can't do this so their humans MUST.
- Designated 'dangerous dogs' and 'guard dogs' are not permitted in this area.
- All humans are responsible for the behaviour, welfare and safety of their dog(s) while using this area. Humans are personally liable for any damages or injury their dog inflicts or receives...the City of Camrose is not.
