1. Valid City of Camrose Business License;
2. Confirmation of the existing business complying with Alberta Liquor, Gaming, and Cannabis; if applicable.
3. Concept Plan which includes:
 - a. proposed Patio location and materials;
 - b. entrance and exits and temporary landscaping, fencing/barriers to identify boundaries of Patio;
 - c. location of tables and chairs;
 - d. expected occupant load;
 - e. garbage receptacles;
 - f. signage;
 - g. existing driveways, loading zones, trees, benches, bus zones, parking meter posts, street lamps, and fire department connections; and
 - h. any other information determined by the Development Authority.
4. Copy of Certificate of Liability Insurance;
5. If the applicant is not the building owner, a letter from the property owner, or their appointed agent, authorizing the Applicant's patio development;
6. Current photos of the Business Frontage, Furniture Zone, and Pedestrian Zone; and
7. Letters of support are required from adjacent businesses and landowners when developing an On-Street Patio or Boulevard Patio that expands beyond the effective frontage of the business. These letters are optional, but a suggested courtesy, when not expanding beyond effective frontage.

Upon approval of your application, it will be necessary to maintain compliance with the regulations set out in this Policy.

Operations of the Patio is not permitted within the City of Camrose boulevard until all approvals have been granted, permits issued and agreements executed.
