

City of Camrose Toilet Rebate Program How Many Liters Do I Use Per Flush?

How to Measure:

1. Measure the length (yellow) and width (blue) of the top of the tank and depth (orange) of the water in the tank in centimetres.
2. Now flush the toilet while holding up the ball, so no water is added after the flush. When the flapper closes, you measure the depth of the water again (green).
3. The difference between the total depth and the remaining depth (orange-green) is called the “useable depth”.
4. Now multiply the width and length together with the useable depth (Blue x Yellow x (Orange-Green)).
5. Divide this number by 1000 and you have your liters per flush! If this number is greater than 10 liters per flush, your toilet is considered a “high-flow” toilet and is eligible for the City of Camrose Toilet Replacement Program.
