Golfers can play from the **Blues** (under 55 years of age), **Whites** (55 – 69 years of age), or **Forward tees** (70+ years of age) if they so desire using adjusted Course Handicaps for corresponding Tees.

**Golfers without a Valid Handicap will be assigned a course handicap of Zero.**

#### **SATURDAY'S FORMAT – 10:00 am Shotgun Start**

- 2 Man Best Net Score for 18-Holes combined with a 2 Man 9-Hole Scramble
- **\$10 Deuce Pot**
- **18 KPs worth \$100.00 each [based on a full field of 72 golfers].**
- There will be a Hot dog and a Beer coupon for the first 18-holes and then restaurant service and prizes at the end of the day.

#### Prizes will be awarded for

- 1 LOW GROSS golfer playing from the BLUES [**Must hole out on every hole to be eligible**] will be named the LAMB FORD Labour Day Classic Champion, with 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> .... Low Gross as well as Low Net Individual winners based on a full field of 72 golfers.
- Teams will be relighted after the 2 Man Best Net score for a 9-Hole 2 Man Scramble using the Front and the Back 9
  - **2 Man Best Net Scores** will be added to the 2 Man Scramble Scores to determine the LOW NET TEAM CHAMPIONS, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, etc as well as Low Gross based on a full field of 72 golfers.
- **All ties will be broken by the use of a pencil comparing best score on each of the highest handicapped holes starting with Hole #1, Hole #16, Hole #9, etc. Lowest Score wins. This is not a countback.**
