AQUATIC CENTRE

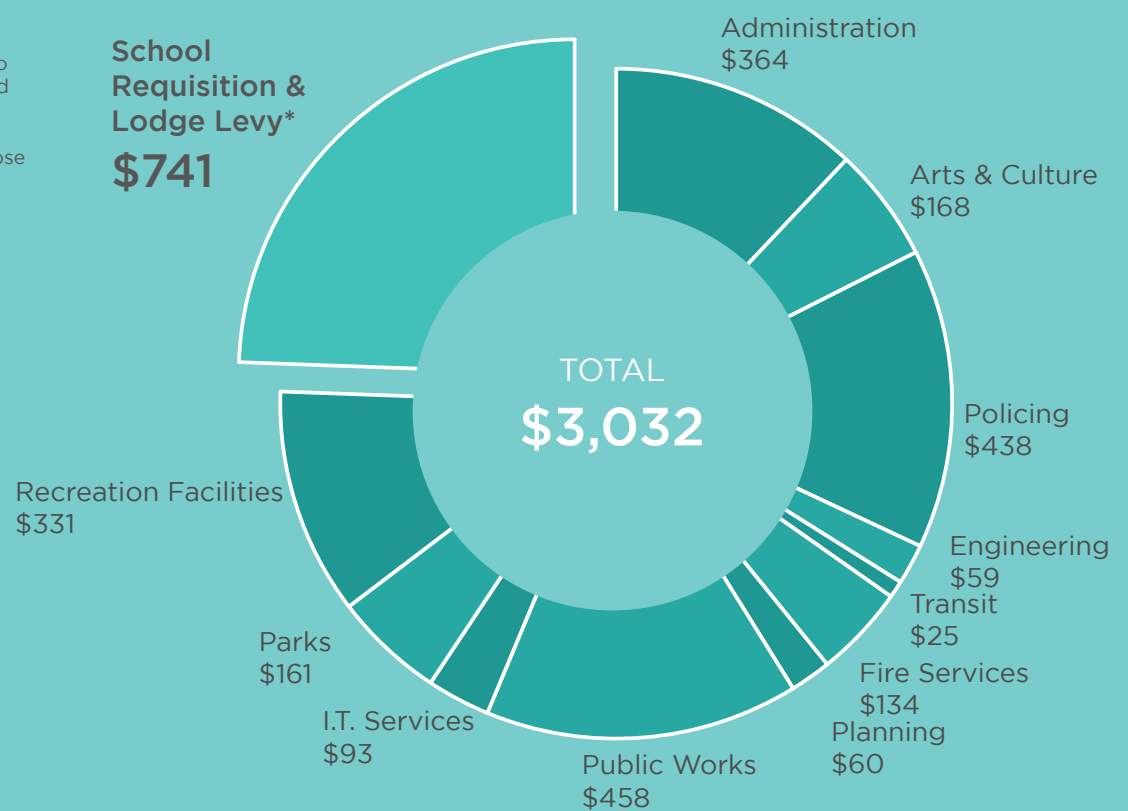
