



BLIND CAT

A FUN TRADITIONAL GAME

A fun game that helps build coordination, hearing, and spatial awareness!

YOU NEED:

A blindfold (such as a scarf or kerchief).



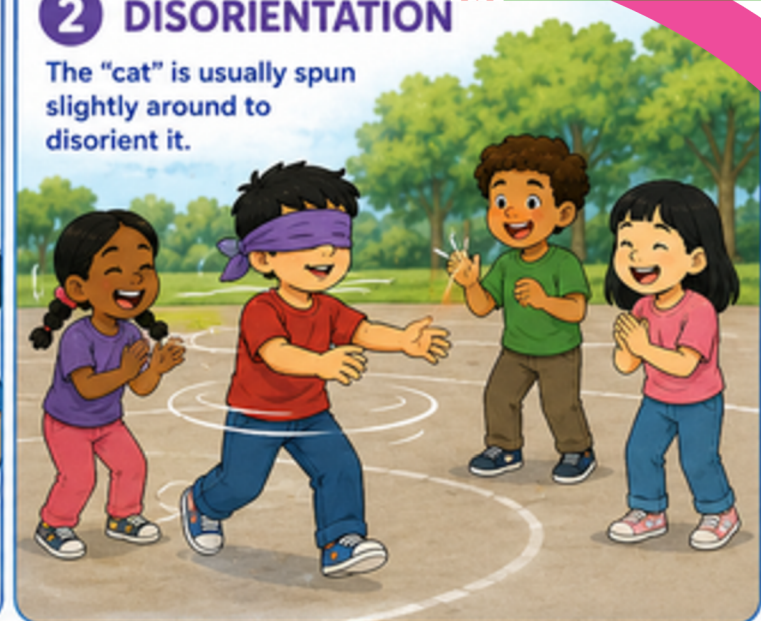
1 CHOOSING A LEADER

A leader—the “blind cat”—is chosen by counting out a rhyme. The blind cat is tightly blindfolded with a scarf or kerchief.



2 DISORIENTATION

The “cat” is usually spun slightly around to disorient it.



3 PROCESS

Players run around the court, clapping their hands or making sounds to attract attention.



4 CATCH & GUESS

The “cat”’s goal is to catch any of the participants and guess who it is by touch.



5 ROLE CHANGE

The person caught and correctly named becomes the new “blind cat.”





RING-RING

A FUN TRADITIONAL GAME

A fun game of luck, quick thinking, and teamwork!

YOU NEED:

A small object such as a ring, coin, or button.



1 SET UP

All players sit in a row and hold their hands together in a cupped “boat” shape. Choose one player to be the leader.

2 SECRET PASSING

The leader holds the ring in their hands. They walk down the row, placing their hands over each player’s cupped hands while pretending to pass it. The leader secretly leaves the ring with one player without others knowing.



3 THE CALL

After visiting everyone, the leader steps back and says:

“Ring-ring, come out onto the porch!”



4 THE ESCAPE

The player with the ring quickly jumps up and tries to run to the leader. The other players try to guess who has the ring and gently stop them before they escape.



5 NEW LEADER

✓ If the player with the ring escapes, they become the new leader!



✗ If they are stopped, the same leader stays in and the game starts again!
