

HIGHLIGHTS

TOURISM OPPORTUNITY IDENTIFICATION PROJECT

The goal of this project is to identify real tourism investment opportunities in Camrose. The key to fully realizing the tourism potential for the City of Camrose is ensuring that future tourism opportunities and development are both pragmatic and strategic. The City of Camrose received a 90% grant through the Small Community Opportunity Program and awarded a contract to Legacy Tourism Group as consultants on this project. This phase of the project will conclude in December, 2024 with 10 prospectuses. These prospectuses will include preliminary market research and other information to support the recommended tourism businesses in Camrose. We look forward to expanding the supporting and existing tourism experiences available in Camrose.

The seasonal peak of building permits, especially for smaller projects like renovations, deck projects, and fences proceeded as expected for Q3 of 2024.


NON-EXEMPT DEVELOPMENT PERMIT VALUES



DEVELOPMENT TRENDS

2023 was an exceptional year for development in the City of Camrose. Although we anticipated a slower 2024 year for development permits, the year-to-date (YTD) estimated taxable construction value at the end of Q3 was still above the 5-year average (excluding 2023).

There is a strong seasonality to small permits and Q2/Q3 are substantially busier than Q1/Q4. 2024 has been on-par for minor permits relative to the last few years.

The name stuck but the festival moved to Camrose in 1993.
