Volunteer Opportunities & Job Descriptions

Date: July 1, 2026

Time: Event runs from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Location: Camrose and District Centennial Museum Grounds

Thank you for your interest in volunteering for Camrose's Canada Day celebrations! Below is a list of volunteer roles available, including responsibilities, shift times, and who to report to.

Volunteers are the heartbeat of this event – your energy and enthusiasm help make this day special for our community!

1. Gate Security Volunteers

Needed: 10 (in rotating shifts)

Location: North Barricade, South Barricade, Vendor Barricade

Shift Length: 30 mins to 1 hour

Time Needed: 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Duties:

- Monitor barricade access to ensure only authorized personnel enter
 - 8:00 AM- 10:30 AM - Market/Food Truck Vendor Access
 - 11:00 AM - 4:30 PM – No Road Access
 - 4:30 PM - 5:00 PM - Open Barricades
- Greet patrons and answer basic questions
- Communicate with event staff regarding any issues
- Rotate stations as needed

Reporting To: Museum Supervisor

2. Game Station Volunteers

Needed: 8-10 (2 per station)

Stations: 5 stations with 2 games each

Shift Length: 30 minutes to 1h at one station (rotate throughout day)

Time Needed: 10:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Duties:

- Explain how to play each game at various scheduled game stations
- Reset games between players
- Hand out game cards
- Stamp game cards upon completion
- Direct patrons to the Museum front desk to enter their completed cards into the draw

Note: Volunteers under 12 must be accompanied by an adult

Reporting To: Museum Supervisor

3. Swag Wagon Attendants

Needed: Flexible (3-6 recommended)

Shift Length: Flexible within event hours

Time Needed: 10:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Duties:

- Walk around event grounds handing out Canada Day swag (stickers, flags, pins, etc.)
- Engage with guests in a friendly, festive manner
- Replenish swag supplies as needed

Reporting To: Museum Supervisor

4. Watermelon Cutting & Distribution Volunteers

Needed:

- 6 Adults (Cutting)
- 6 Youth or Adults (Distribution)

Shift Length: Flexible shifts throughout the day

Time Needed: 10:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Duties:

- Cut and prepare watermelon for guests
- Hand out watermelon slices to patrons
- Maintain cleanliness of serving area

Reporting To: Recreation & Culture Supervisor

Volunteer Requirements:

- Must **sign a Volunteer Form** before the event
 - Must attend a **mandatory training session** (details to follow)
 - Must **sign in/out** at the volunteer check-in area
 - Must show up on time and stay for the duration of assigned shift
 - Help with **clean-up at the end** of your shift or event
 - Volunteers will be scheduled for **breaks** and provided with **water & snacks**
 - Some groups (non-profit) may receive **an honorarium** for their help
