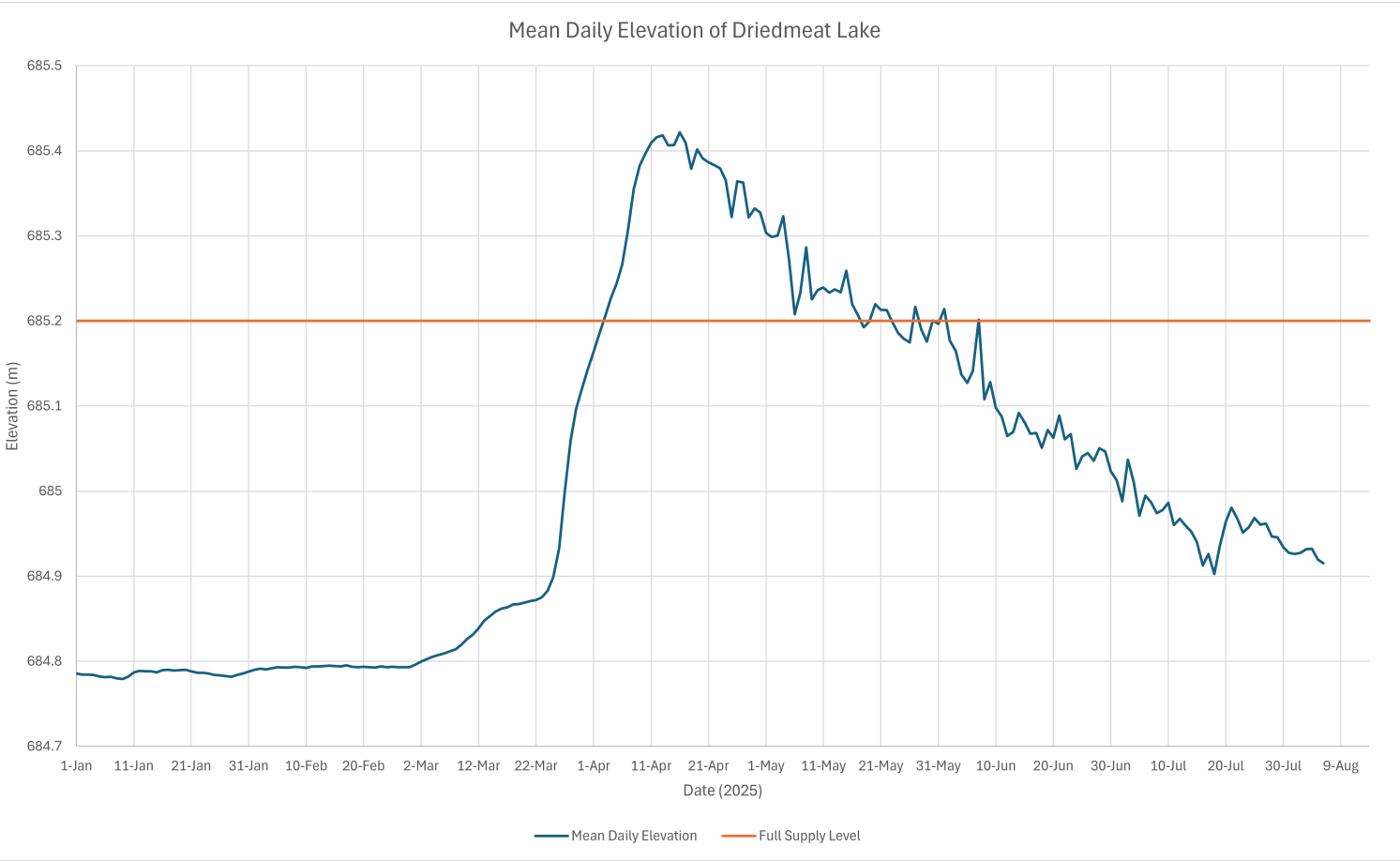


CURRENT WATER SITUATION

August 12, 2025



With temperatures staying below 30°C, some rainfall, and the ongoing conservation efforts of Camrosians, the rate of the lake level drop appears to have slowed. The upcoming forecast is not showing extreme heat, and some showers are expected. With these factors in mind, the City is hopeful that we will not need to move into Stage 2 of our Water Restrictions Bylaw this year.

However, it is likely that we will remain in Stage 1 unless we receive a significant amount of wet weather from now into the fall. If the lake level remains low at the end of the year and we receive little snowfall over the winter, we may need to enforce water restrictions earlier in 2026.

We appreciate the community's efforts to reduce outdoor water use, as these actions positively impact our water supply now and in the future.
